Thank you for your continued support of this incredible event. 2022 marks our 84th year hosting The Riverside Best Ball, and we're excited to host you for the weekend.

Attached you will find a schedule of events, local rules information, basic tournament information, and a detailed listing of divisions and starting times.

As I write this, we are not allowed to have indoor dining. However, our patio near the Grille and the Balcony above it will be available. You will receive two drink tickets per player that can be used for any beer, soft drink, or basic mixed drink.

Some additional notes to consider:

- ***There is an optional Friday Stableford team cash game (\$50), and a gross skins cash game within the divisions for Saturday and Sunday (\$50 per round, \$100 total).***
- ***You are expected to rake bunkers, and fix ball marks.***
- ***We will be using Golf Genius this year to score the event. Please download the Golf Genius app before play on Saturday. One person per foursome will be responsible for keeping score digitally.***
- ***Other than trophies, winnings will be emailed directly to you in the form of a gift code, redeemable at the golf shop.***
- ***Round Two Pairings will be released after completion of play on Day One. We will do our best to accommodate everyone, while trying to provide an am/pm start for each team unless requested otherwise.***

PLEASE NOTE:

Teams in each division will be re-paired for Sunday based upon their Round One gross score. You may visit the official website <https://riversidegcc.com/BestBall.aspx> on Saturday evening. Results, pairings, and tee times will also be available on Golf Genius using a code which will be provided at the practice round.

It is the players responsibility to know his tee time for both days.

Tournament Information

- Format:** Four-Ball Stroke Play ~ all players will play their own ball throughout the round. The lower gross score between partners on each hole will count as the team's score for the hole. 36-hole competition.
- Doubt as to procedure:** USGA Rules of Golf 20.1c (3): you may complete the hole with two balls. You must inform your playing competitors of which ball you intend to use. Please allow the committee to determine the ruling prior to signing your scorecard.
- Handicaps:** **NOTE: May 16th Handicap Indexes will be used.**
Maximum handicap differential between partners is 5.
Sutton Division ~ maximum team handicap of 18.
Perkins & Beeber Division ~ maximum team handicap of 26.

Player's handicap indexes are converted to a course handicap, based upon tees played. Players will receive 50% of their individual handicaps.
- Divisions:** Sutton Division ~ Age 18 to 49
Perkins Division ~ Age 50 to 59
Beeber Division ~ Age 60 & older
- Scoring:** The top (2) gross teams and the top (2) net teams in each division will receive crystal trophies and credit book. Additionally, 1/3 of the field will be awarded Riverside Golf Shop gift certificate in each division, gross and net.
- Teeing Grounds:** Sutton Division ~ Black tees (approximately 6,739 yards)
Perkins Division ~ Blue tees (approximately 6,467 yards)
Beeber Division ~ White tees (approximately 6,104 yards)
- Ties:** Gross Champion ties (all divisions) ~ Hole-by-hole playoff beginning on the 18th hole. If needed, we will use the 1st hole followed by the 17th and then 18th and repeat this until a winner is decided.

Other ties ~ prize money will be split, but ties will be broken for trophies by round two 18-hole score. If still tied, the USGA recommended method will be performed using round two scorecards.
- Optional Competition:** Gross skins ~ \$100 cash per team (\$50 allocated to each day) per division. Cash paid out to winners.

Local Rules & Information

- ✓ **USGA Rules govern all play except where modified by local rules.**
- ✓ **Out of Bounds** is defined by property lines, boundary fences, and white stakes.
- ✓ **Penalty Areas** are marked with red lines and stakes.
- ✓ **Ground under repair** is identified by white lines.
 - Flower beds and planters are considered ground under repair. Please do not play from these areas. You are allowed a free drop if the ball has been deemed to come to rest in the flower bed.
- ✓ The **Embedded Ball Rule** is in effect in the General Area.
- ✓ USGA approved **distance measuring devices** that provide yardages are allowed. Features on the device that allow for elevation, wind, or any measurement other than raw yardage shall be disabled.
- ✓ **Sprinkler Heads near Green in Line of Play:** If a ball lies in a “Closely mown area” and an immovable obstruction (sprinkler head) on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and hole, the player may take relief as follows:
 - The ball must be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay that (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids intervention and (c) is not in a penalty area or on a putting green.
 - The ball may be cleaned when lifted.
 - Exception: A player may not take relief under this Local Rule if interference by anything other than the immovable obstruction makes the stroke clearly impracticable.
